Mustard oil is used in several dishes as the cooking medium. But ghee is preferred in temples. In olden times, food was traditionally served on banana leaves or disposable plates of Sal leaves.

Some of the popular rice dishes in Odisha are Khechidi that is cooked with rice, lentils and ghee; Palau that has vegetables, dry fruits and spices. Sweet rice dish, Kanika prepared from dry fruits and ghee. Ghee rice and Pakhala the watered rice , this tasty dish is served with curd and stir-fried vegetables.
