Plants are living things that grow all around us. They are very important for life on Earth. Plants give us oxygen to breathe and food to eat. Without plants, humans and animals cannot survive.

There are many types of plants such as trees, shrubs, herbs, and climbers. Big plants like mango and neem are called trees. Small and bushy plants are called shrubs. Very small plants with soft stems, like mint and coriander, are known as herbs. Some plants, like money plant and grapevine, need support to grow and are called climbers.

Plants need sunlight, water, air, and soil to grow. The roots of a plant absorb water and minerals from the soil. The stem carries water to different parts of the plant. Leaves prepare food for the plant with the help of sunlight. This process is called photosynthesis.

Plants are also helpful in many other ways. They give us fruits, vegetables, wood, medicines, and shade. Trees help to keep the air clean and make the environment cool. That is why we should take care of plants and grow more trees to save our Earth.
